Programs and competitions

NetSetGo

Each Saturday morning our young players participate in the Woolworths NetSetGo program where they learn and develop their netball skills. The program focuses on netball related skills and activities.

5 to 7 year olds participate in the **Net Program** where they spend half the time practising their netball skills followed by playing half a 'game' with another team.

8 to 9 year olds participate in the **Set Program** where they play a full game of netball based on modified rules.

10 year olds play in the **Go Competition** where they play a full game of netball based on the full set of netball rules. However, they play reduced time in each quarter.

Junior competition

Each Saturday morning our junior players aged 11 to 14 years play in age-based competition games based on full rules.

Junior players aged 15 to 17 years play in age-based competition games each Saturday afternoon.

Senior competition

All players aged 18 years and over are graded into teams based on ability.

How to register

All player, coach, umpire and non-player registrations must be completed online at <u>PlayHQ</u>. All registration and game fees are payable at the time of registration.

All players must be registered before they can take to the court in a game.



What is included in registration?

All registration fees include:

- Netball Australia registration fees
- PlayHQ administration fees
- Netball NSW registration fees
- Bankstown City Netball Association registration fees
- Birrong Sports Netball Club registration fees
- Birrong Sports Netball Club game fees that cover the cost of providing umpires for games
- Insurance for injury sustained during training or a game (insurance may be limited).

BSNC works hard to keep all fees as low as possible.

BSNC does not want any player to miss out on playing netball due to financial hardship. Therefore, if any player or family requires financial support, BSNC will work with you to ensure you are able to register and play the game you love. Contact the Club to make arrangements.

When teams reach the 13 years age group and above, the team must have a minimum of 2 players who are active umpires for the Club or who are willing to learn how to umpire.

No team will be registered with BSNC if the team does not meet this criteria.
